




Title – HACCP training,2O23

Date – O2nd September 2O23






Title - World Tribal Day






Title: National Webinar on NEP - Reforms in Teaching, Learning and Assessment



Date – 10th October, 2023



Date - 14th September 2023



Title - UGC -HRDC RUSA Refresher Course in Environmental Studies (Multidisciplinary)


Theme: Environmental management for Sustainable Development
