

2. Objective of the Practice

- Alumni are great mentors for current students as they can share their insights about the competitive market for opting better opportunities

3. The Context

Alumni associations have been a part of educational institutions. "Enriching Expressions" activity makes optimum use of alumni expertise to conduct Alumni – student knowledge exchange programmes like professional lectures, panel discussion, etc.

4. The Practice

Lecture/workshop series 'Enriching Expressions' involves organisation of talks/workshops/discussions by eminent alumni in their area of expertise. The students are benefited by the experience of the alumni in topics of current areas of research etc. Every year during the annual reunion, eminent Alumni are felicitated. This year Mr. Parmanand Bhatia an alumnus of the microbiology department was felicitated. Mr. Parmanand Bhatia is the cofounder of Lab Diagnostics Pvt Ltd. A rapid covid-19 test of this company was approved by the ICMR last year.

Every department of the college seeks to develop innovative courses through alumni engagement. One such initiative has been taken up by the Department of Chemistry - A skill







enhancement course titled 'Business skills for Chemists'. This course is designed for TYBSc Semester V and conducted by the alumni of the chemistry department who are working in the industry for 10 to 15 years and are well versed with their domain. 104 TYBSc students enrolled for this course in academic year 2020-21.

Alumni are regularly involved as judge for department festivals of Biochemistry. Chemistry department organised Panel discussion with Alumni during "Rasayan" festival. In panel discussion present students interviewed alumni about their career path. Physics department organised career guidance session by alumni.
