



MEGA BLOOD DONATION DRIVE 2020

Conducted by The NSS Unit of K. J. Somaiya College of Science and Commerce

"The best way to find yourself is to lose yourself in the service of others!"

COVID-19 brought much of the world to a screeching halt, isolating people in their homes, taking kids out of school and closing the doors to many businesses. Despite this, hospitals across the country remained open and operational, dedicated to providing lifesaving care to patients. But the need for blood donation existed on a very large scale. Also a misconception of contracting corona infection through blood transfusion prevailed very much in people's minds. By implementing proper sanitization and following all the social distancing rules, one cannot catch corona infection, but still the haunting thought of contracting corona infection still exists. It also came to the notice of The NSS Unit of KJSSC that there was an acute shortage in the number of blood units available in the city. It was a really frightening situation. After observing the entire scenario, the NSS Unit of KJSSC thought of conducting a 'Mega Blood Donation Drive' in the entire city under the guidance of our Principal Dr. Pradnya Prabhu Ma'am and NSS P.O Mr. Amit More Sir. The Drive was launched on October 01, 2020 and was conducted till November 08, 2020. In this drive, a poster was circulated in the entire city which consisted of a registration form link for interested blood donors to register themselves for blood donation. Along with this, an online canvassing was conducted by the NSS volunteers on various social media sites which not only highlighted the importance of blood donation during pandemic but also cleared people's misconception regarding donating blood in pandemic time. The NSS unit conducted different online meets to appeal to the blood donors to come forward and donate blood and also requested them to share a word about the NSS blood donation drive with their friends and family. With the assistance of NSS Director of Mumbai University, Mr. Sudhir Puranik Sir, we were able to gain information about the different blood banks in Mumbai District. We received 91 blood donors registrations from central mumbai. Then, the donors were segregated according to their areas and seven groups were formed and thus seven blood donation camps were organized. The entire NSS blood donation drive was led by NSS Leaders Mr. Robinsh Yadav, Miss Hamsika Kondamudi, Mr. Omkar Sagvekar and RRC Head Miss. Amisha Kaswankar.

The First Camp of the Mega Blood Donation Drive was conducted at Bhandup on October 15, 2020 and was led by Mr. Omkar. It was organized in collaboration with Rajawadi Hospital Blood Bank, Ghatkopar. For that camp we got 91 blood donors who came and donated blood. Five NSS Volunteers staying in Bhandup the adjoining areas of Bhandup were present at the camp and assisted the medical staff during the camp. The camp was carried out peacefully and was considered as a great beginning of the Blood Donation Drive. The Second Camp of the Mega Blood Donation Drive was conducted at Vidyavihar on October 16, 2020 and was lead by Miss Riddhi Desai. It was organized in collaboration with Somaiya Blood Bank, Vidyavihar. 26 Blood Donors turned up at the event and donated blood. 4 NSS Volunteers staying in Ghatkopar and Vidyavihar were present at the camp and helped the medical team in filling the forms and in coordination of the camp. The camp was a great success and was carried out without any hindrance. The Third Camp of the Mega Blood Donation Drive was conducted at Badlapur on October 18, 2020 and was led by Mr. Amey Rane. It was organized in collaboration with Rajawadi Hospital Blood Bank, Ghatkopar. For that camp, 51 blood donors were present at the camp and they donated blood. 3 NSS volunteers staying in Badlapur worked as helping aids for the medical team. The camp was carried out without any hindrance and was a huge success.

The Fourth Camp of the Mega Blood Donation Drive was conducted at Ambernath on October 28, 2020 and was led by Mr. Robinsh Yadav single handedly. It was organized in collaboration with Somaiya Blood Bank, Vidyavihar. Initially there were only 13 blood donors registered from Ambernath but after the canvassing done by an NSS volunteer staying in Ambernath, 33 donors turned up at the blood donation camp and donated blood. There was only a single NSS volunteer staying in Ambernath who assisted the medical staff and also donated blood. The camp was carried out without any obstacles and was again a great success. The Fifth Camp of the Mega Blood Donation Drive was conducted at Thane on October 30, 2020. It was organized in







collaboration with Sarvodaya Samarpan Blood Bank, Thane. For the blood donation camp, 34 blood donors attended the camp and donated blood. 6 NSS Volunteers staying in thane were also

present at the camp and helped the medical staff. Two NSS volunteers Mr. Omkar and Mr. Bhavesh also came forward and donated blood during the camp. This camp was indeed carried out smoothly, turning out to be a huge success.

The Sixth Camp of the Mega Blood Donation Drive was conducted at Karjat on November 07, 2020 and it was led by Miss. Dhanashree Kadam singlehandedly, who later also donated blood during the camp. It was organized in collaboration with Sarvodaya Samarpan Blood Bank, Thane. Initially there were only two registrations from Karjat, but after the Initiative taken by an NSS volunteer staying in Karjat, 24 blood donors turned up at the camp and donated blood. During the camp only a single NSS volunteer was present and worked as a helping aid for the medical staff. The NSS volunteer also donated blood and gave her utmost contribution for the blood donation camp. The Seventh Camp of the Mega Blood Donation Drive was conducted at Dombivli on November 08, 2020 and was led by Mr. Aakash and Mr. Dhairya. It was organized in collaboration with Plasma Blood Bank, Dombivli. For that camp, 25 blood donors were present and they donated blood. 7 NSS volunteers were present at the camp who assisted the medical team and two NSS volunteers also donated blood during the camp. The camp was carried out peacefully without any hindrance.

The entire Mega Blood Donation Drive which was carried out 6 weeks turned out to be a massive success. The Drive also got overwhelming response from the Blood Donors in various areas and many people from the society also came forward and assisted in the canvassing of the activity. The NSS P.O and The entire NSS Unit worked dedicatedly and sincerely while carrying out this activity. The entire blood donation activity turned out as a reminder of hope and bravery in such crucial times. The courage and willingness shown by the blood donors was commendable and highly inspiring. MEGA BLOOD DONATION DRIVE 2020

COVID-19 brought much of the world to a screeching halt, isolating people in their homes, taking kids out of school and closing the doors to many businesses. Despite this, hospitals remained open— dedicated to save lives. But the need for blood units existed on a large scale. The KJSSC NSS Unit noticed the frightening scarcity of blood units in Maharashtra and decided to launch 'Mega Blood Donation Drive' in Central Mumbai. The Drive was launched on October 01, 2020 under the guidance of our Principal Dr. Pradnya Prabhu and NSS Programme Officer Mr. Amit More and was conducted till November 08, 2020. Mr. Sudhir Puranik, The Director of the NSS Cell of the University of Mumbai, helped the NSS Unit acquire information about different blood banks. We started online canvassing to highlight the need of blood donation during this pandemic, and spread the posters along with the registration link. We received 91 registrations and then segregated those city-wise in seven groups and then arranged online meets with each group to explain the details of the drive and safety precautions. We also requested the registered participants to spread this word; which resulted in successful completion of the 7 blood donation camps. The entire Blood Donation Drive was managed by our NSS Leaders Mr. Robinsh Yadav, Miss. Hamsika Kondamudi, Mr. Omkar Sagavekar and RRC Head Miss. Amisha Kaswankar.

The **First Camp** was conducted in Bhandup on October 15, 2020 and was led by Mr. Omkar Sagavekar, NSS Boy Leader. It was organized in collaboration with Rajawadi Hospital Blood Bank, Ghatkopar. Five NSS Volunteers staying nearby were present and assisted the medical staff. The campaign kick-started with a massive total collection of 91 blood units.

The **Second Camp** was conducted on October 16, 2020 in Somaiya Vidyavihar Campus and was led by Miss. Riddhi Desai. It was organized in collaboration with Somaiya Blood Bank, Vidyavihar. 26 Blood Donors turned up and donated blood., 4 NSS Volunteers staying in Ghatkopar and Vidyavihar were present for the assistance of the medical staff and for smooth running of the camp. The camp turned out to be splendid.

The **Third Camp** took place in Badlapur on October 18, 2020 under the leadership of Mr. Amey Rane. Total 51 blood units were collected in this camp. Rajawadi Hospital Blood Bank collaborated in this too. 3 NSS volunteers from Badlapur worked as helping aids to make sure the smooth and successful completion of the whole event.

The **Fourth Camp** was conducted in Ambernath on October 28, 2020 in collaboration with Somaiya Blood Bank, Vidyavihar. It was managed by KJSSC NSS Leader, Mr. Robinsh Yadav. Initially there were only 13 registered blood donors. However after consistent canvassing, 33 donors showed up at the blood donation camp. Mr. Robinsh not only assisted the medical staff









alone but also donated the blood. The camp was carried out without any obstacles and was exceptional.

The **Fifth Camp** of the Mega Blood Donation Drive was conducted in Thane on October 30, 2020. It was organized in collaboration with Sarvodaya Samarpan Blood Bank, Thane. The event was managed by Mr. Yogesh Vilas Ghalsasi Sir. 34 blood donors attended the camp and donated blood. Among the 6 NSS Volunteers present at the camp to assist the medical staff, 2 volunteers came forward to donate blood. This campaign was carried out with perfect coordination and turned out to be a huge success.

Miss. Dhanashree Kadam, newly enrolled NSS Volunteer, single-handedly led the Sixth Blood Donation Camp of Karjat. It was organized in collaboration with Sarvodaya Samarpan Blood Bank on 07th November, 2020. Initially there were only two registrations from the city but after the incessant efforts by Miss. Dhanashree, 24 blood donors donated the blood including herself. Thus, it resulted in a grand success of the **Sixth Camp** of the Mega Blood Donation Drive.

The **Seventh Camp** was conducted in Dombivli on November 08, 2020 and was managed by Mr. Aakash Shedge and Mr. Dhairya Malde. It was organized in collaboration with Plasma Blood Bank, Dombivli. In this camp, Total 25 donors including 2 NSS volunteers donated blood. While 7 NSS volunteers were present to assist the medical team. With this camp, the 'Mega Blood Donation Drive' Campaign marked its end.

The overwhelming response from Blood Donors was very admirable and the courage and willingness was highly inspiring. Their contribution to the community evoked a sense of gratefulness in the volunteers. Those 6 weeks were excruciatingly busy but satisfactory, volunteers worked throughout this Drive in a very commendable manner. We collected a whopping sum of 284 blood units. कोविड -१९ ने संपुर्ण जगाला विळखा घातला आहे, लोकांना त्यांच्या घरांमध्ये कैद केले, मुलांना शाळेतून बाहेर काढून अनेक व्यवसाय ठप्प केले. असे असूनही, रुग्णालये रुग्णसेवेसाठी समर्पितच राहिली. परंतु या काळात रक्ताची आवश्यकता मोठ्या प्रमाणात जाणवून आली. क. जे. सोमैया विज्ञान आणि वाणिज्य महाविद्यालयाच्या रा. से. यो. युनिटने महाराष्ट्रातील रक्ताची भयावह कमतरता लक्षात घेतली आणि मध्य मुंबईत 'भव्य रक्तदान शिबीर' सुरू करण्याचा निर्णय घेतला. आमच्या प्राचार्या डॉ. प्रज्ञा प्रभू आणि रा. से. यो. चे कार्यक्रम अधिकारी श्री. अभित मोरे यांच्या मार्गदर्शनाखाली, 01 ऑक्टोबर 2020 रोजी भव्य रक्तदान शिबीर सुरू करण्यात आले आणि 08 नोव्हेंबर, 2020 पर्यंत चालविण्यात आले. मुंबई विद्यापीठाच्या रा. से. यो. संचालक, श्री. सुधीर पुराणिक यांनी युनिटला वेगवेगळ्या रक्तपेढ्यांविषयी माहिती मिळविण्यात मदत केली. या साथीच्या रोगादरम्यान रक्तदानाची गरज ठळक करण्यासाठी त्यांनी ऑनलाइन प्रचार सुरू केला आणि नोंदणी फॉर्मसह पोस्टर्स पसरवण्यात आले. या तून आम्हाला ९१ रक्तदात्याच्या नोंदणीतून रक्तदानास सहभाग मिळाला, नोंदणीकृत रक्तदात्याच्या शहरानुसार रक्तदात्यांचे सात गटात विभाजन करण्यात आले आणि त्यानंतर शिबीर व सुरिक्षततेच्या तपशिलाचे स्पष्टीकरण देण्यासाठी आणि त्यांना रक्तदानाविषयी माहिती देण्यासाठी विनंती करत प्रत्येक गटासह ऑनलाईन मिटीमगची व्यवस्था करण्यात आली; ज्यायोगे ७ रक्तदान शिबिरे यशस्वी झाली. सर्व रक्तदान शिबीरांची जबाबदारी कु. रॉबिन्स यादव, कु. ओमकार सागवेकर, कु. हंसिका कोंडामुदी आणि कु. अमीषा कसवणकर यांनी सांभाळली.

१५ ऑक्टोबर, २०२० रोजी भांडुप येथे प्रथम शिबिराचे आयोजन करण्यात आले होते या शिबिराचे नेतृत्व कु.ओमकार सागवेकर ह्याने के ले. राजावाडी रुग्णालयाच्या रक्तपेढीच्या सहकार्याने या शिबिराचे आयोजन करण्यात आले होते. जवळच राहत असलेल्या रा. से. यो.च्या पाच स्वयंसेवकांनी उपस्थित राहून वैद्यकीय कर्मचाऱ्यांना मदत केली. एकूण ९१ रक्तपिशव्याच्या संकलनाने शिबीर यशस्वी झाले.
