



Report of the interactive Session "Career options in Management"

On 15th July 2017, an interactive talk session was organized by Department of Biochemistry for T.Y.B.Sc. and M.Sc students of the Department. Ms. Himani Chawhan, Head, Senior Research Associate, Learning mate was invited for a talk titled "Career options in Management".

The session started with a brief introduction of the speaker by Dr. S. M. Pawaskar, Head, Department of Biochemistry. Ms. Himani then started her talk by informing students about various career opportunities after the graduation and post graduation. She explained the importance of post graduation in getting job opportunities and elaborated on its importance for career growth. She insisted students to opt for postgraduation. She then talked about the opportunities in sales and marketing and explained about the skills needed to pursue these career options. Information on industry oriented courses was given to the students. She then talked about various opportunities after pursuing MBA. Competitive exam details and schedule of various exams were provided to the students.

There was an overwhelming response from the students in the form of questions related to the career options after degree and Postgraduation. The session ended with a vote of thanks to the speaker by Dr. S.M .Pawaskar. The overall session was very encouraging, interesting and informative.







Report of the interactive Session "Career options in Food Auditing"

Mr. Satish Kumar Gupta (Senior Assessor/ Food Scheme Manager, Indian Register Quality Systems (IROS), Mumbai) conducted a talk on "Career Opportunities in Food Auditing" for the UG and PG students of the department of Biochemistry (K.J. Somaiya College of Science and Commerce) on the 4th of August, 2017.

We were very privileged to receive extremely valuable insights about Food Auditing which gave us a new perspective about building our careers. Being students of pure sciences our ideas of a career naturally sway only towards pursuing research and settling into a professional/industrial setting. Food auditing is a crucial component of maintaining the food safety standards through a provision of transparency and assurance that the standards are being maintained.

As mentioned by Mr. Gupta, food auditing is not limited to only professionals from a specific stream but is open to a wide range of educational qualifications given that the individual is competent enough to meet the job requirements. His talk provided us with further information about the details of the profession which included the various designations and kinds of food auditing. As told to us my Mr. Gupta, there exist three kinds of audits, namely; first party, second party and third party audits. A first party audit involves an internal audit within the company while a second party audit involves the company auditing a supplier or a client auditing the company. A third party audit involves an audit which is carried out by another certified organisation (for example an audit which will be conducted by an independent organisation if a company needs an ISO certification)

We also learnt that a minimum 2 year work experience in the relevant field is needed to get recruited as a food auditor. In addition to the above mentioned criteria, a successful completion of the Lead Auditor training is mandatory to be a third party auditor.

After this enlightening alumni talk, I'm sure that all of us are in the better position to efficiently analyse the pros and cons of food auditing as a career and to consider it as a prospective career option.

At 11.00 am, students reached at convention hall of BSE Building. A small documentary film was shown on a big screen. This film gave information about the history of BSE i.e. the manualtrading process of BSE and gradually, how BSE turned into automated live stock trading systemat Dalaal Street.

The training session started at 11.15 am with National Anthem, followed by a lecture by Prof. Anita Toshniwala (first speaker) from BSE Institute. She spoke about the events affecting stockmarkets. She gave examples of current scenario of Demonetization, and how the market sentiments will change the trading volume on the stock exchange. She also spoke on international events which are having ripple effect on the Indian stock market. This was an interactive and enlightening session. The most interactive students from TYBAF, TYBMS and TYBcom bagged prizes during the session.

At 12.30 pm, Prof. Rakesh Nair from BSE Institute—(second speaker) spoke about the industrydriven post graduate program in Banking and Finance, Masters in Global Financial Markets.





These programs provides hands on experience on the banking software. The overall session had enlightened students with the factors behind price behavior of the sensitive index of BSE and career opportunities at BSE Institute recognized by UGC.


