Also a course on Research Innovation Programme through RiiDL could be offered for the benefit of Science and Commerce students as well. Industrial projects could be invited since the faculty has been trained for use of Schrodinger software for Drug designing. Corporate relationship with regular programs will help skill development amongst students.
- There is a need to anticipate and identify the problems faced by the students in the ongoing lockdown period.

#### Feedback:

• In the next academic year, it could be planned to obtain a 360<sup>0</sup> feedback for a holistic view of the institution. Help from external agencies could be sought. There is scope of taking feedback from peers during the department audit. Also, the Head of the departments from various subjects from other Colleges could be engaged in the peer feedback process. Also a comparative analysis of the curriculum with that of the other colleges should be obtained. Feedback from the employers from different industries could be obtained. Students could be involved in framing the feedback questions.

#### **RST-GIS Centre:**

• External members expressed concern over the existing space for the RST-GIS centre. The house was informed that the facility will now be shifted to the fourth floor of the KJSSC building. Also, the possibility of having the weekend version of the courses should be explored.
